

Sammu City is situated in the eastern part of Chiba Prefecture, about 18 km from Chiba City and New Tokyo International Airport at Narita and within the range of about 60 km from central Tokyo. Located almost in the middle of the Kujukurihama coastal area, the city faces the Pacific Ocean for a distance of about 8 km and has a total area of 146.38 sq. km. Sammu City was established on March 27, 2006, through the merger of four municipalities in Sanbu-gun county: Naruto-machi, Sanbu-machi, Hasunuma-mura, and Matsuo-machi.
