When using land (*Tochi*), constructing a building, you need to find out if there are any ruins (*Iseki*).

Ruins (*Iseki*) are important places where traces of the lives of people in the past remain.

If you would like to find out them, consult with the City Hall < Museum of History & Folklore (*Rekishi Minzoku Shiryō Kan*) >.

After you have finished your research, you are able to use the land.

If there are ruins (*Iseki*) on it, Sammu City will inquire into them.



Those who use the land should pay the cost of the survey.

If the land is larger than 1000 m, consult with < Museum of History & Folklore (Rekishi Minzoku Shiryō Kan) > .
