Rules for Disposing of Garbage

In Sammu City, garbage bags are determined by where you live. Follow the rules when you put out your garbage.

Use the table on the next page to find out which area you live in.

If you live in Naruto area, look at pages 44 to 57.

If you live in Sanbu, Hasunuma or Matsuo area, look at pages 58 to 70.

To find out when you put out your garbage, refer to “the poster that explains how to dispose of garbage(*Gomi no dashikata poster*)”.

● Why are the garbage bags separated?

Because this is to reduce the amount of garbage.

There are different types of waste: Burnable Waste (*Kanen Gomi*), Noncombustible Waste (*Funen Gomi*), Recyclable Waste (*Shigen Gomi*), and Hazardous Waste (*Yūgai Gomi*).

Recyclable Waste (*Shigen Gomi*) is replaced by a different type and is used again. By being recycled, the amount of waste is reduced.

Therefore, separate your garbage properly.
