## When you are sick, there is a fire and car accident

If you feel unwell and cannot move, call 119.

If a fire breaks out, call 119.

If you are in a traffic accident, call 110

It's free. You are able to make a call at any time.

Call the numbers and say the following.

## (1) When you suddenly feel sick or injured

Call "**119**". An Ambulance ( *Kyūkyū Sha* ) will come. When you call, say the following

- ① "I'm not feeling well." ( I'm in bad shape or injured )
- ② Where you are now.
- 3 Age and gender ( man or woman ) of the person who is sick or injured.
- 4 Who did what?
- ⑤ Your name and phone number.



## (2) When a fire breaks out

Call **"119"**. A <u>Fire Engine ( Shōbō Sha )</u> will come. Say the following on the phone.

- ① "There is a fire."
- ② Where is the fire?
- ③ What is on fire?
- 4) Are there any injured people or people who failed to escape from the fire?
- ⑤ Your name and phone number.



Call **"110"**. A <u>Police Officer</u> ( *Keisatsu Kan / Kei Kan* ) will come. Say the following on the phone.

- ① "It's a traffic accident."
- 2 When did the accident happen?
- ③ Where did the accident occur?
- 4 Are there any injured people?
- ⑤ Your name and phone number.

\*Fire Engine ( Shōbō Sha ): Cars with fire extinguisher
