# **1** How to dispose of garbage ( *Gomi no Sutekata* )

There are several types of garbage.

### 2 Do not make a loud sound

Do not play music loudly at home.

Do not speak in a loud voice that can be heard by the next door neighbors.

If your house and the house next door are close to each other, you may hear loud noises and voices.

Be careful not to cause any trouble to the people in the next house.

# **③** Please be quiet at night.

Sammu City is a quiet town.

Some people go to bed early at night.

Be careful not to make noise outside.

Please be quiet in your house.







## 4 Park your car in a parking lot.

If you park your car on the road, you will disturb the people around you.

It is very dangerous to leave your car parked on the road.

Park your car in a designated parking lot.

Where you live, there are wards / community associations ( *Ku, Jichikai* ) Communicate with your neighbors and get along with them.








# 6 Put a nameplate and mailbox at your house.

Put a mailbox in your house so that you can receive letters.


Also put a nameplate on your mailbox.
