



Taxes are used to better police, fire department, roads, water supplies, pensions, medical cares, welfares, and educations.

“Taxes” are the money we all pay for these things.

Taxes paid to Sammu City are as follows.

Municipal Prefectural Tax

(*Shi Kenmin Zei*)



You pay taxes to the municipality where you live on January 1.

You will receive a tax payment slip around May or June.

Pay the tax at banks, post offices, convenience stores, or City Hall.

Property Tax

(*Kotei Shisan Zei*)



Those who own land or buildings on January 1 pay the tax.

You will receive a tax payment slip around May.

Pay the tax at banks, post offices, convenience stores, or City Hall.

Light Vehicle Tax

(*Kei Jidōsha Zei*)



Those who own Motorized Bicycles (*Gendōki Tsuki Jiten Sha*) and Light Cars (*Kei Jidō Sha*) on April 1 pay the tax.

You will receive a tax payment slip around May. Pay the tax at banks, post offices, convenience stores, or City Hall.
