



There is an allowance for raising children and systems that provide free medical treatment when you take your child to see a doctor. For more information, contact < the Child Rearing Support Section (*Kosodate Shien Ka*) > of the City Hall.

(1) Child Allowance (Jidō Teate)

This is an allowance for children up to the age of 15 (by the time they graduate from a junior high school).

Apply for it at < the Child Rearing Support Section (*Kosodate Shien Ka*) > of the City Hall.

- < Bring the followings >
 - ① Passbook (*Tsūchō*)
 - ② Individual Number Card (Kojin Bangō Card / My Number Card)



(2) Child Medical Expense Subsidy (*Kodomo Iryōhi Josei*) (Free medical expenses)

This is a system that allows children to receive free medical care until they are 15 years old (by the time they graduate from junior high school).

First, enroll your child in <u>health insurance</u> ($Kenk\bar{o}\ Hoken$).

After that, apply at <the Child Care Support Section (*Kosodate Shien Ka*)> of the City Hall.

< Bring the followings >

- ① Seal (Inkan / Hanko)
- ② Child's Health Insurance Card (Kenkō Hokenshō / Hoken Card)
- Individual Number Card (Kojin Bangō Card / My Number Card) for the guardian and child.
- 4 Medical Expenses Receipt
- ⑤ Passbook (*Tsūchō*)

(3) Medical expenses for high school students (*Kōkōsei Tō Iryō Hi*) (Return of medical expenses)

This system subsidizes the medical expenses of high school students and others (students between the ages of 16 and 18) to reduce the financial burden on their quardians.

Apply at <the Child Rearing Support Section (*Kosodate Shien Ka*) > of the City Hall.

You can get a refund of the medical expense.

< Bring the followings >

- ① Seal (Inkan / Hanko)
- ② Child's Health Insurance Card (Kenkō Hokenshō / Hoken Card)
- ③ Individual Number Card (*Kojin Bangō Card / My Number Card*) for the guardian and child
- Something that shows that your child is in school. < <u>Student ID (*Gakusei Sho*)</u>
- (5) Medical Expenses Receipt
- 6 Passbook (*Tsūchō*)

**Student ID (*Gakusei Sho*): A document or card that says you are a student at a school. Students receive this at school.
