If your house and the house next door are close to each other, you may hear loud noises and voices.


Be careful not to cause any trouble to the people in the next house.

## When you are sick, there is a fire and car accident

If you feel unwell and cannot move, call 119.

If a fire breaks out, call 119.

If you are in a traffic accident, call 110

It's free. You are able to make a call at any time.

Call the numbers and say the following.

#### (1) When you suddenly feel sick or injured

Call "**119**". An <u>Ambulance (*Kyūkyū Sha*)</u> will come. When you call, say the following

- 1 " I'm not feeling well." ( I'm in bad shape or injured )
- ② Where you are now.
- ③ Age and gender ( man or woman ) of the person who is sick or injured.
- ④ Who did what?
- (5) Your name and phone number.



#### (2) When a fire breaks out

Call **"119"**. A Fire Engine ( *Shōbō Sha* ) will come. Say the following on the phone.

- ① "There is a fire."
- ② Where is the fire?
- ③ What is on fire?
- ④ Are there any injured people or people who failed to escape from the fire?
- (5) Your name and phone number.

#### (3) When a traffic accident occurs

- Call "110". A Police Officer ( Keisatsu Kan / Kei Kan ) will come.
- Say the following on the phone.
- ① "It's a traffic accident."
- ② When did the accident happen?
- ③ Where did the accident occur?
- ④ Are there any injured people?
- (5) Your name and phone number.

\*Fire Engine ( Shobo Sha): Cars with fire extinguisher

\*Ambulance (*Kyūkyū Sha*): Vehicles to transport injured or sick people.

\*Police Officer (Keisatsu Kan / Kei Kan): People working at a police station







In case that disaster strikes

Japan is prone to many <u>Disasters ( Saigai )</u> such as Earthquakes ( Jishin ), <u>Tsunamis</u> (<u>Tsunami</u>), <u>Floods ( Kōzui</u>), and Landslides ( Gake Kuzure ). When a disaster occurs, evacuate. Also, do the following (1) to (4). Evacuate to a safe place as described in the table on pages 9 to 12.

> The Disaster Prevention Administrative Radio

#### (1) Gather information.

- Disaster Prevention Administrative Radio ( *Bōsai Gyōsei Musen* ) It is a radio to listen to information about disasters.

#### ④ Emergency Earthquake Alert (*Kinkyū Jishin Sokuhō*)

It will make a sound during a large earthquake. Run to a safe place.

A large earthquake may cause Tsunamis. Evacuate to a higher place.

Listen to it with your cell phone or smart phone.

\*\*Disasters (*Saigai*): Earthquakes and lots of rain that damage houses, land, and people.
\*\*Tsunamis (*Tsunami*): Very high waves
\*\*Floods (*Kōzui*): A river overflows and flows a lot on the land.
\*\*Disaster Prevention Administrative Radio (*Bōsai Gyōsei Musen*): A machine that you can listen for information about disasters.
\*\*Sammu City Hazard Map: A map you are able to get at City Hall. It shows the dangerous places in Sammu City.
\*\* Emergency Earthquake Alert (*Kinkyū Jishin Sokuhō*): Information provided by the Japan Meteorological Agency. A loud sound is made when a major earthquake occurs.
\*\*Landslide Sediment Disaster (*Dosha Saigai*) : A lot of stones and muddy water falling down from mountains due to earthquakes and rain.

#### (2) Run to safety.

Run to a safe place near your house.

The place to run to will be announced via the Disaster Prevention Administrative Radio ( *Bōsai Gyōsei Musen* ).

Use the following table to remember the safe places near your house.

In the event of a tsunami, run to higher ground.

Go to the top of the buildings

- Designated Emergency Evacuation Sites (*Shitei Kinkyū Hinan Basho*) are places where you are able to be evacuated in the event of a disaster.
- Designated Evacuation Sites (*Shitei ippan Hinan Jo*) are places where affected people are able to stay for a few days in the event of a disaster.

#### (3) In the next cases, evacuate immediately.

- 1 When a notice from the City Hall come to you that you should evacuate.
- ② When heavy rains, tsunamis, or landslides are likely to occur.
- $\ensuremath{\textcircled{3}}$  When disaster threatens to destroy your home
- ④ When your house is on fire
- ⑤ When your neighbor's house is on fire and yours is about to catch on fire.

#### (4) Before you evacuate, do the following

- ① Put out a fire.
- ② Turn off the gas.
- $\ensuremath{\textcircled{3}}$  Turn off the electricity. Turn down the breaker in your house.
- ④ Write down on a piece of paper where you will run to. Leave it in your house.
- ⑤ Take a safe route.

that you buy or sell cars, lands and buildings.

It is also used when creating a company.

Ka ) > at the City Hall.



 $<\,$  What is an Individual Number Card ?  $>\,$ 

An Individual Number Card is a plastic card which contains an IC chip, and the bearer's name, address, date of birth, sex, 12 digit My Number ( the Individual Number ), and ID photograph, etc., are displayed on it.

This card can be used as an identification card for identity verification.

#### (1) When can you use it ?

- ① When you open a bank account.
- ② When you obtain <u>a resident's record( Jyūminhyō</u>) and <u>a Certificate of Seal</u> Registration ( Inkan Tōroku Shōmei Sho ) at convenience stores.
- ③ When you use it as your health insurance card.
- ④ When you send money to abroad.
- (5) When you file a income tax return on-line.

#### (2) How to make an application for your Individual Number Card

- Those who have an address in Sammu city can apply for an Individual Number Card.
- ② Come to the City Hall.
- ③ Fill out an application form.
- It is possible to take a ID photograph at the City Office.
- If your period of stay is less than three months, please apply for an Individual Number Card after updating your period of stay.







#### (3) How to receive your Individual Number Card after applying

- About 30 days after applying for an Individual Number Card, Sammu city will send you an issue notice (postcard-type notice).
- ② Please contact Sammu city office and book a date to collect your card.

#### (4) Be careful !


#### (1) What is National Health Insurance?



It is a system to reduce the money you pay at clinics or hospitals. To use the system, you need to pay taxes.

When you take out National Health Insurance, you will be given an <u>Insurance</u> Card ( *Hoken Shō / Hoken Card* ). Take it with you when you see a doctor.

Medical expenses to clinics or hospitals are as follows.



#### (2) The following people are not eligible for National Health Insurance.

- Those covered by the company's Social Insurance ( *Shakai Hoken* ).
- Those who have Social Insurance to pay for their lives.
- People older than 75 years old
- Those who are receiving Welfare Benefits ( *Seikatsu Hogo* )
- Those who live in Japan for less than three months

#### (3) National Health Insurance Tax (Kokumin Kenkō Hoken Zei)

If you are enrolled in the National Health Insurance program, you will be charged the "National Health Insurance Tax (*Kokumin Kenkō Hoken Zei*)". The tax must be paid by the deadline for payment. The amount of money to be paid in one year is determined by the person's salary for the previous year.

#### (4) How to pay the National Health Insurance Tax



# How to dispose of Household Garbage (Narutō area)

If you would like to dispose of <u>Household Garbage ( Katei Gomi )</u>, buy the designated

garbage bags at a store in Narutō area.

The types of garbage bags depend on the types of garbage.

Garbage Collectors are not allowed to take garbage bags that are not sorted by type.

If you would like to put out your garbage, separate it into different types as described on the next page.

Dispose of garbage at a Garbage Collection Point ( *Gomi Station* ) by 8:00 in the morning.


- Paper material ... 3cm or smaller thickness of the paper can be thrown away.
- Disposable diapers … Get rid of feces and dipose of it in the toilet.
- Plastic material ... Plastic goods, Styrofoam materials, and Plastic containers for food and beverage, detergent, air freshener, etc.

Please sort waste into burnable waste and recyclable waste ( cans, bottles, and plastic bottles ).

- Cloths … It is also possibe to be brought to The Collection Facilities( *Recycle Sōko* ).
- Leathers ... Bags, belts, shoes, etc.
- Food oils ... Solidify it by using a coagulant.
- Rubber … Cut rubber hoses into 1m or smaller.
- Small plush toys
- Small tree branches and leaves
  - ••• You can dispose of tree branches that length is 50cm or smaller and thickness is 12cm or smaller.

Dry and remove the soil on the tree branches and leaves.

- Sea shells







Check the document and dispose of the garbage again.







There are many cases in which the Garbage Collection Points (Gomi Station) for (1) Burnable Waste< *Moeru Gomi* >, (2) Recyclable Waste< *Shigen Gomi* >, (3) Noncombustible Waste< *Moenai Gomi* >, and (4)Hazardous Waste< *Yūgai Gomi* > are different.



Illegal dumping < Dumping waste at non Garbage Collection Points (Gomi Stations), or not obeying the rules for garbage disposal > is a crime. "Noyaki" < Burning off the fields > is also a crime. For more information about Garbage Collection Points (Gomi Stations), contact < the Environmental Conservation Section (*Kankyō Hozen Ka*) > at the City Hall.

Garbage Collectors are not allowed to take garbage bags that are not sorted by type or garbage that is not able to be collected. Confirm the garbage that you thrown away is collected or not. Garbage Collectors will put a document on garbage that is not able to be collected. The document states the reason why the garbage is not able to be collected. Check the document and dispose of the garbage again.

#### (10) Companies that are approved of carrying garbage

When carrying garbage of another person, it is necessary to get a license from Sanmugunshi Environmental Sanitation Association (*Sanmugunshi Kankyō Eisei Kumiai*).

If you don't have a license, carrying garbage of another person is a crime.

There are illegal cases in which you make a request to non-licensed companies or person for carrying your garbage.

You can apply for collecting your garbage to licensed companies.



- 1 Toilet that uses a septic tank ( Jyōkasō system )
  - The septic tank needs to have a periodic check by a vendor.
  - The number of periodic checks is specified by law.
  - Please have the septic tank cleaned when having periodic checks.
  - Please have the septic tank cleaned more than once a year.

  - You need to pay the cost for your septic tank periodic check and clean up.





### (1) When you keep a dog

#### 1 Registering a dog

If you have started keeping a dog, come to the City Hall within 30 days and register your dog. You can register a dog over 90 days after birth.



#### **2** Vaccinations

All dog owners are required to have their dogs vaccinated against <u>rabies</u> at animal hospitals. And then, come to the City Hall with "a certificate of rabies vaccination

(*Kyōkenbyō Yobōchūsya Sumishō*)". You can get "Rabies vaccination tags (*Kyōkenbyō Yobōcyūsya Sumihyō*)" at the City Hall.

Be sure to get a vaccination once a year.

It is required by law to register a dog and get a vaccination against rabies annually. Please make sure to do it.

#### **③** Cost of registration

Registration fee 3,000yen

Rabies vaccination tags issuance fee550yenTotal amount 3,550yenThose who have 10 dogs and over need to report to Sanbu Public Health Center.







### (2) When you keep a cat

Please keep your cat inside the house.

Be careful not to cause any trouble to the people in the next house because of cat excrement or loud sounds.

Please make your cat undergo <u>a sterilization operation</u> or <u>a castration operation</u>. Make sure to carry an identification tag or microchip to avoid your cat getting lost. Do not feed stray cats.

If you feed stray cats, you need to take care of them.



A It is NOT possible to put out them as recyclable waste( plastic bottles ). The containers for food and beverages with the following recycling logo can be thrown away as recyclable waste( plastic bottles ).



Put the container without a recycling logo in the burnable garbage bag.



# **Q10** Why didn't the garbage collectors pick up the garbage which you threw away?

A Garbage Collectors are not allowed to take the following garbage bags.

The garbage bags that are not allowed to be collected	The garbage bags that are thrown away on non collection days
What you need to do	Put out the garbage on the correct collection day. To find out when you should put out your garbage, refer to "the poster that explains how to dispose of garbage".

The garbage bags that are not allowed to be collected	The garbage bags that are not sorted by type
What you need to do	Garbage Collectors will put a document on garbage that are not able to be collected. The document says the reason why the garbage has not been collected. Sort by type and dispose of the garbage. To find out how to sort garbage, refer to pages 44 through 70.

## **Q11** When you can put out your garbage?

**A** Rules of how to dispose of garbage depend on the area you live in. Use the table on pages 42 and 43 to find out which area you live in.

Dispose of garbage on the morning of the collection day.
Narutō area · · · Put out garbage by 8:00a.m.
Sanbu, Matsuo, and Hasunuma area · · · Put out garbage by 8:30a.m.

If you put out garbage at a different time such as the night before collection day ,it will cause trouble for your neighbors. It will cause the garbage to be littered and cause a bad smell.

# **Q12** Is it possible to make a request of putting out household garbage to friends or acquaintances?

A When you carry and put out the garbage of another person, it is necessary to get a license. When you ask someone to carry the garbage, make a request to licensed companies. ## Q13 How to dispose of company's waste

- A There are two types of company's waste which are "Industrial waste", and "Municipal solid waste". To find out what types of company's waste you have, ask Sammu City< Environmental Conservation Section( *Kankyō Hozen Ka* ) >. There are two ways of putting out company's waste.
  - Way of asking licensed companies to put them out.
     You can not make a request to non-licensed companies.

## $\mathbf{Q14}$ Is it possible to dig a hole and bury garbage in the ground ?

- A It is NOT possible to dig a hole and bury garbage in the ground. Illegal dumping < Dumping waste at non Garbage Collection Points ( Gomi Stations ), or not obeying the rules for garbage disposal > is a crime. Illegal dumping leads to going to jail or paying a fine. Do not bury garbage in the ground.
